

DROP OFF AND PICK UP ZONES

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL PARENTS

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- Students may be dropped off and picked up at the PASSENGER ZONES located in Ernest Street and Oceana Tce. These are the only two designated/legal drop off points for students. Dropping or collecting students in Kooralgin Street (near the church driveway) is an illegal practice. Parents are reminded that the success of Two Minute Zones (“kiss and ride”) requires cooperation from all drivers to ensure quick movement of vehicles through the area.
- If the two minute zone is full, parents must not continue to wait in the street for their turn to enter the queue. This practice creates traffic congestion, road rage and potential accidents. We are fortunate at SJV that we are able to just circle the block and try again. This is a much safer alternative.
- You MUST NOT leave your vehicle under any circumstances whilst in the two minute zones. Drivers cannot wait in the two minute zone while another adult drops their children into the school grounds.
- The two minute zone in Oceana Tce begins from the signage and not from the road/line markings. The marking indicates a bicycle lane only and does not relate to the drop-off, pick-up area. The drop off, pick up areas are painted green on the curb gutters and are marked by the signage. Therefore if you are parking in Oceana Tce, you must park behind the signage after the private driveway.
- Parents not observing the correct procedure for these zones, are advised that the police will be called to issue infringement notices to offending drivers.

WELLINGTON STREET WALKING BUS

- To avoid the stress of the pick up zones in the afternoon, please consider the “worry-free” alternative pickup point of Wellington Street which is located next to Nagle House in Kooralgin Street.
- Ample parking is available.
- Children gather in the courtyard near the office after the second bell and are escorted by a teacher down to Wellington Street at approximately 3.10pm.
- Any students not collected at Wellington Street will be walked back to the school by the teacher to await their parents.
