



Year 2 Religion Curriculum Overview

Term 1

Year 2 will recognise the sacredness of God's creation, including all human life and the way in which they can continue to be stewards of the environment through helping to care for their world. Students will be invited to participate in a variety of personal and communal prayer experiences.

Term 2

Year 2 will make connections between Jesus' teachings and the way members of the community live today. They will look at the informal act of forgiveness and how the 'four steps to forgiveness' helps to restore relationships. Students will look at stories in the Bible where people showed compassion and forgiveness and apply this to their own daily lives and actions.

Term 3

Year 2 will make connections between Jesus' healing ministry and the sacrament of Penance. They will look at the life and times of Jesus and his loving actions as depicted in New Testament Bible stories where he displayed healing, forgiveness and compassion to others.

Term 4

Year 2 will identify aspects of God's nature as revealed in the Bible. They will discuss ideas about God's relationship with the Jewish people as depicted in the Old Testament. Students will compare and contrast the two different versions of the Infancy Narrative to develop their understanding of Bible authorship.
